## WEEK 3: LAW & ORDER

### READINGS:

EX 20: 1-17 | 1COR 1:22-25 | JN 2:13-25

### OVERVIEW:

When Moses came down from the mountain, stone tablets in hand, the commandments God gave him seemed straight forward. It still didn't stop the people from making decisions that led them away from God. A challenge we still face today.

What we all need in our life is a little more Law and Order from a faith perspective... Not just a set of rules but using God's law as pathway to live a happy, healthy and holy life.

### REFLECTION & JOURNAL QUESTIONS:

1. We are taught the Ten Commandments as one of the first things we learn about as Christians. Which Commandment do you most struggle to understand and how can you learn more about all of them?
2. Paul tells the Corinthians that God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom; reminding us we don't have all the answers. Where do you need to rely on the Holy Spirit's Gift of Wisdom more in your life?
3. We all can drift from the laws God gives us or make decisions which put Him second behind things of this world. Are there situations in your life you are experiencing where God was once first and now you have allowed things of this world to replace Him?

### LOOKING FORWARD:

We can tend to drift away if we aren't making our checklist daily to reflect where we've gone wrong disobeying the laws of God. This is key to know when it's time for reconciliation to restore a little order in our lives.

Take some time to learn more about the fullness and depth of each of the ten commandments, as well as make some personal time for reconciliation.
