## WEEK 4: FAITH IN ACTION

### READINGS:

2 CHR 35:14-16, 19-23 | EPH 2:4-10 | JN 3:14-21

### OVERVIEW:

There comes a time when we must listen to what God is asking of us by answering the call God places before us to be His messenger. Today we must say “Yes” to what we believe by putting faith into action... even if it makes us uncomfortable.

Just like in the days of the prophets, the Father needs authentic messengers to help tell the story of His love and bring light to a world covered in darkness.

### REFLECTION & JOURNAL QUESTIONS:

1. The messengers of God were mocked in a time the world had severely fallen away from God. Is there a time you have been challenged by others for what you believe? How did you respond? How do you wish you would have responded or how would you respond the next time in the same situation?
2. Paul tells the Ephesians that God’s grace gives us everything we need to live our faith. He also challenges us to do the works God has called us to do. What are the gifts God has given you to do His work in the world and how are you doing it? How can you do even more?
3. God gave us His son to prove His love for us. What are you sacrificing to show your love in return?

### LOOKING FORWARD:

It is our job to evangelize in a way that brings people back, not because of what we read, say, or believe, but because HOW we live our faith.

By the power of the grace of God, have courage this week to share faith and the message of Christ’s love with someone who needs it. Whether stranger, friend, or family, it might be your words and living example that help them see the beauty of God’s love.
